We invite you to increase your experience in kayaking in canoe polo come and try sessions and ongoing training - and we can arrange to meet specific interests such as rolling and rescue.

What is Canoe Polo?

Canoe Polo is at best a fast, energetic, skilful game played in swimming pools and lakes. It's like basketball in a kayak, in slow or fast play.

- There are rules for safety and fairness.
- Treasured skills are learning to paddle well, and to roll.
- Male or female, young or old, play, at local level often together.

Everyone is welcome

Coaches and players guide learning and training. Officials keep us running/paddling! Beginners enjoy the game, gaining new in-water confidence, enjoying the outdoors social life.

- Division 1 provides for high-power players
- Division 2 is open to all others, encouraging team play and confidence
- Come and try sessions offer you a taste, but you could end up playing for your state or country, relatively soon.

Costs

Initial costs are low compared to many sports:

- Cheap registration, with a two-month introductory membership, then Canoe Club fees, to cover Insurance and support our Code of Conduct.
- Pool entry fees when playing at hired swimming pools
- Free training at West Lakes and Mawson Lakes
- Equipment free for new and casual players (then borrow; or buy cheap second-hand boats)

Competitions

Adelaide Canoe Club and Northern Districts Canoe Club run shared events.

- Winter games ACC: indoor pools on Saturday or Sundays.
- Warmer months NDCC: Mawson Lakes (Sundays 6 weekly and practice in between).
- Interstate competitions 4 or 5 times a year, including a national championships at Easter

Training/Practice Sessions

Various and varying training options with newcomers are always welcome – people develop skills surprisingly rapidly.

- Coaching and team practice Corcoran Drive West Lakes Sunday mornings (9-11 am)
- Development coaching as advertised at Club websites (at West Lakes and Mawson Lakes)
- Come and Try at the new from time to time field at Bartley Bridge, West Lakes
