How to apply

To apply to be the Contingent Leader (AJ2019) you will need to fill in the online application form.

To submit an application, you will need to be able to answer the following:

- Part 1: Name, Membership Number, Scout Group, Date of Birth, Email Address, Mobile Number
- Part 2: Previous related experience (positons, events, roles),
- Part 3 What are your interests?
- Part 4 What experience do you have in the development of teams to run activities or courses?
- Part 5 Cover Letter upload
- Part 6 Upload of a plan relevant to the position
- Part 7 Resume and CV upload
- Part 8 Reference Contact Details (We will not accept references from family members)

Note: applications must be completed and submitted in one go, they cannot be saved and completed in stages so prepare all the documents and responses before starting the online form.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in an interview with a selection panel consisting of youth members and Adult Leaders
