## Latest COVID Advice - 24 February 2022

As you are aware, we sent a communication to all leaders on the 24th January in regards to a ban on camping and overnight activities until week 4 of the School term in line with the Dept of Education directives.

Many of you would be aware that the department of education has since extended their restrictions on School camps until week 9 of the School term.

As the Chief Commissioner, I recognise that camping is an essential part of the Youth program, so, while we encourage you to postpone your camps where possible, camping is still able to go ahead under strict COVID-safe guidelines.

If your camp is booked at either Woodhouse Activity Centre or Roonka and you are able to postpone or reschedule then please contact them direct for assistance in changing dates or refunds.

When camping or having sleepovers, please maintain social distancing of 1.5 metres with sleeping locations; where not possible, maintain 50% capacity e.g a 4 man tent should only house 2 people.

All Groups need to ensure these guidelines are met at Scout Halls and on Camps to ensure a COVID-safe camp.
