PERMISSION

TO TRAVEL INTERSTATE OR OVERSEAS

Some activity venues will be interstate or overseas and require travel.

Individual members or groups of members who wish to travel as Scouts outside the Branch are to:

- Comply with the requirements of *Policy and Rules*.
- Comply with the requirement of Branch Rules and Policies.
- Obtain a permit by application to Branch Headquarters.

T1 Application for Approval to Camp or Travel Interstate forms are available and shall be lodged not less than two (2) months prior to the intended date of departure. In case of overseas trips, three (3) months notice is required.

Upon receipt of approval notification from interstate Branch, the Leader in Charge of the party will be advised.

Members proposing to travel overseas as representatives of the Association shall seek prior approval of their own Branch in accordance with Branch Rules. Branches shall advise the Australian International Commissioner of all overseas travel by Australian Scouts. (P & R, Rule 15.1)

Requests to other Branches in Australia for assistance with arrangements and accommodation may only be made in compliance with these procedures.

A completed T1 *Application for Approval to Camp or Travel Interstate* form will grant permission for travel and will provide contacts needed.

It will still be necessary to obtain the Program Adviser's or Branch Commissioner's specific authority to conduct the adventurous activity envisaged. The District Commissioner shall be informed of any such activity.

Approval will not be given by the Branch for parties of Joey Scouts, Cub Scouts, Scouts, Venturers or Rovers to travel to a host Branch whilst a National event appropriate to their Section is in progress.
